"Dress Like Jesus"

Big Idea: God's people should dress like those who belong to Jesus!

I. By Putting | vv.12-14.

- 1. Putting on as God's chosen ones, Holy and beloved [Christian identity].
 - a. Chosen ones: God chose us before the foundation of the world. "The elect of God" (KJV).
 - b. <u>Holy</u>: We have been set apart for God and for his purpose
 - c. <u>Beloved</u>: God chose us not because of anything good in us but simply because he loved us Chosen, holy & beloved identity in the OT → Deuteronomy 7:6-8 Chosen, holy & beloved identity in the NT → Ephesians 1:4-55
 - Chosen, noly & beloved identity in the NI \rightarrow Epnesia
- 2. Putting on the Character of Christ [Christian lifestyle].
 - "Put on" → means "clothe yourselves" with...
 - a. <u>Compassionate hearts</u>: Feeling or showing sympathy and concern for others
 - i. (bowels of mercies, KJV) | The bowels were regarded by the Hebrews as the seat of the tenderer affections; especially benevolence and good will.
 - b. <u>Kindness</u>: Being friendly, generous, and considerate.
 - i. Ephesians 4:32 | "be kind to one another, tenderhearted...."
 - c. <u>Humility</u>: Having a true estimate of yourself, not thinking too highly or lowly of yourself.
 - i. Philippians 2:3 | "do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves."
 - d. <u>Meekness</u>: strength under control; gentle sprit in willing submission to God and others.
 - e. <u>Patience</u>: longsuffering with others; forbearance, slowness in avenging wrongs.
 - i. Fruit of the Spirit \rightarrow Galatians 5:22-23
 - f. <u>Bearing</u>: to endure patiently or put up with other.
 - i. God's Character \rightarrow Psalm 145:8
 - g. <u>Forgiving</u>: To pardon; do something pleasant or agreeable (to one), to pardon
 - i. Matthew 18:21-22 | How many times should I forgive?
 - ii. Matthew 18:21-35 | The Parable of the Unforgiving Servant
 - h. <u>Love</u>: the Greek word is "agape", meaning good will, benevolence. It is beautiful self-sacrificing, unconditional love with which God loves us in Christ.
 - i. Matthew 22:26-40 | The Greatest Commandments
 - ii. 1 Corinthians 13 | The way of love

II. By Letting | vv.15-16.

- 1. Letting the "peace of Christ" rule in your hearts.
 - a. "Peace" \rightarrow refers to the peace that Christ brings into relationships within the body of Christ
 - b. "Rule" → Umpire
 - c. "Called" \rightarrow relates back to the word "chosen" in v.12;
 - d. Ephesians 4:3-4 | The bond of peace
- 2. Letting the "word of Christ" dwell in you richly.
 - a. The teachings of Christ
 - i. Colossians 1:5 |The word of truth, the gospel & Colossians 1:6 | The grace of God in truth
 - b. "Dwell" \rightarrow refers to be at home in; to take up residency permanently.
- 3. Letting the "singing of Christ" with thankfulness in your hearts to God.
 - a. "Psalms" \rightarrow refers to psalms in the Old Testament.
 - b. "Hymns" \rightarrow refers to songs of praise to God.
 - c. "Spiritual songs" are just general songs with reference to spiritual matters.
 - i. Spiritual communicates the influence of the Holy Spirit's filling in the believers acts of praise

III. By Doing | v.17.

- 1. Doing everything in the "name" of the Lord Jesus.
 - a. "everything" \rightarrow means the whole of life. Everything in word, thought, deed, and attitude.
 - b. 1 Corinthians 10:31 "So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God."
- 2. Doing everything "through" Jesus.
 - a. This can only be done with dependency on Jesus and empowered by the Spirit
 - b. Colossians 2:6 | "just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live in him.
