

"Jesus' First Priority" - Sermon Notes - Matthew 6:33

Introduction

- 1. "Seek You First..." It's implied that we seek.
 - We seek because we have needs.
 - Matthew 6:8 "...your Father knows what you need before you ask him. Pray then like this:"
 - Matthew 6:32 ""For the Gentiles seek after all these things (food, clothing, drink), and your heavenly Father knows that you need them all."
 - We are in need because of who we are in our being.
 - God is the only All Sufficient being.
 - o God is omnipotent Hebrews 1:3, Mt. 19:26, Luke 1:37, Psalm 147:5, Job 42:2
 - o God is omniscient Psalm 139:7-12, Heb. 4:13, Mt. 9:4,
 - o God is omnipresent Psalm 139:7, Col. 1:17, Mt. 18:20, Jer. 23:23-24
 - o God is sovereign Eph. 1:11, Rom. 8:28, Mt. 10:29-31, Col. 1:17-17
 - o God is immutable Num. 23:19, Psalm 102:25-27, Heb. 13:8
 - o God is Holy 1 Sam. 2:2, Ex. 15:11, Rev. 15:4
 - God is Sufficient 2 Cor. 3:5, Ex. 3:14, Psalm 46:1
 - We are in need because we are sinners. Rom. 3:23, Rom. 6:23, 2 Tim 3:16; Mt. 10:17, Mt. 11:28-30
 - In eternity we will still lack in our being, but sin and its effects will be eradicated. − 1 Cor. 1541ff, 1 John 3:2, Rev. 21:4, Rom. 8:18-19,
 - All of our needs are met in Jesus and His righteousness Mt. 6:33

The First Empty Way to Fill Our Needs

We seek "all these things" in order to build "our kingdoms" in the attempt be made right.

- Things of this world "All These Things" created things or people
 - Matthew 6:32, "For the Gentiles seek all these things..."
 - People Matthew 5:27ff Lust, Divorce Mt. 7:7:1-5 Judging Others
 - > Needs to be met Intimacy, connection, value, belonging, significance, to be desired, cherished, adored, respected, etc.
 - > In the person of Jesus is the only way for this need to be met. "Seek you first the KINGdom..."
 - Things Mt. 6:19ff. wealth, toys, substances, entertainment, etc.

The Second Empty Way to Fill Our Needs

We seek first our "rightness" and God owes us all of these things to give us our own Kingdom.

- Give to the Needy Mt. 6:1-4
- Prayer Mt. 6:15
- Fasting Mt. 6:16-18
 - o Fill in the blank with tithing, bible studies, devotions, charity work, morality, having the right thinking politically and socially or anything you or others deem as good before God.
 - o "In order to be seen" by others- the approval of others. This is Self-validation. Self-recognition. Self-aggrandizement. Self-promotion. Self-recognition. Self-love.
 - Luke 18:9-14, John 5:39, Mt. 7:21ff

Jesus Sought Us FIRST

- Hebrews 13:20ff
 - He who is sufficient emptied Himself...
 - o Phil. 2, 2 Cor. 5:21
 - o To give us sufficiency.
 - John 10:10 "I came that they might have life and have it abundantly."
 - Matthew 11:28-30 "Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light."
- The Lord's Prayer Mt. 6:9-13
 - o "Our Father in heaven"
 - o "You are my real Father, and I am your child and you sought me out through your Son.
 - "Holy be your name."
 - You are All SUFFICIENT.
 - "Your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven."
 - Pour your sufficiency throughout the entire world...in me and through me.
 - "Give us this day our daily bread"
 - You are sufficient for ME, and I trust that you know what I need and will provide what I need.
 - "and forgive us our debts"
 - Forgive me as you have through your Son who sought me and won me to Himself.
 - "as we also have forgiven our debtors"
 - Out of the overflow of your sufficient forgiveness, pour it out of me to others.
 - "And lead us not into temptation"
 - "Keep me from seeking my needs to be filled from any one or thing but you."
 - "but deliver us from evil".
 - Protect me from the evil one who has and will tempt me to believe that I can be filled everywhere but you.
