#### "SOLA SCRIPTURA—SCRIPTURE ALONE"

2 Peter 1:19-21

### THE VITALITY OF SCRIPTURE, v.19

- vital = necessary, essential to life, of crucial importance
- 1. God's Word is more sure (certain) than personal experience.
  - "...we have something more sure, the prophetic word" "prophetic word" = the Bible
  - In previous verses Peter was talking about being with Jesus at the Transfiguration.
- 2. God's Word is spiritually profitable and should not be ignored/neglected.
  - "...to which you do well to pay attention..." Lit. 'to hold the mind on'
- 3. God's Word is like a light shining in a dark place. "...a lamp shining in a dark place..."
  - God's Word is necessary—it shines in a dark place. Ps 119:105
  - God's Word is relevant—it continues to shine. (Gk. tense emphasizes the shining is on-going, continuous)
- 4. God's Word sustains us until the return of Christ.
  - "...until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts." a reference to return of Christ

# THE VALIDITY OF SCRIPTURE, v.20-21

- 1. The Bible is not a revelation of a prophet or apostle. v.20
  - "one's own" = refers to the prophets, apostles, others who wrote the Bible
- 2. The Bible is a revelation from God. v.21
  - "For no prophecy was ever produced by the will of man..." = no part of the Bible originated from man.
  - The Bible did not come from an act of human will. v.21a
  - The Bible came when men moved by the Holy Spirit spoke from God. v.21b
- -2 Tim 3:16: All Scripture is breathed out by God... NIV: "God-breathed"

#### THREE VIEWS OF SCRIPTURE

- 1. The Bible is *not* the Word of God.
  - Some: It is a good book, but just a book. Human authors with great insights, etc. but like any other book.
  - Others: it is actually an evil book, full of errors and lies.
- 2. The Bible is sort of the Word of God.
  - Some is God's Word, but mixed w/man's word and therefore has errors. → It is partly God's Word.
  - Some parts are true, some parts are not true. Bible is not God's Word, but it 'contains' the Word of God.
- → This view is held by liberal Protestants, mainline denominations, many people
- 3. The Bible is the Word of God.
  - It is from God, it is all true, and there are no errors in the original Greek & Hebrew manuscripts.
  - Plenary-Verbal inspiration of the Bible: Literally = "all-words" every single word is God's Word. No errors.
- → The Bible is our only rule for faith (what we believe) and practice (how we live).

## WHAT CHALLENGES THE 'ALONE' OF 'SCRIPTURE ALONE'?

- 1. Church tradition Roman Catholic Popes and Councils
- 2. Personal experience.
  - Religious or spiritual experiences
  - Messages from our story (collection of the people, events, and circumstances that have shaped my life)
- 3. Cultural, social, or political trends.
