

Genesis Chapter 8

The Turning Point: “God Remembered Noah”

Genesis 8 opens with a decisive shift from judgment to mercy. The phrase “*God remembered Noah*” signals not that God had forgotten, but that He was now acting on Noah’s behalf to bring salvation to completion. God sends a wind, the waters begin to recede, the fountains of the deep close, and the rain stops

The Floodwaters Recede

Over the course of 150 days, the waters steadily diminish. Eventually, the ark comes to rest on the **mountains of Ararat**, and by the tenth month the mountain tops become visible.
