Agape Flights provides weekly cargo and mail flights to nearly 300 missionaries in the Bahamas, Haiti, and the Dominican Republic – nations that together represent approximately the population of Florida. Whether it's food, medicine, farm supplies, water filtration, solar power equipment or discipleship materials, missionaries have been depending on Agape's timely deliveries for 43 years.

- We have obtained complete Bibles – OT and NT for the ministry! Each child who regularly attends our Sunday School is given a NT and then a whole Bible.
- Blessed to see so many children faithfully attending our children's service. In March, our average attendance was 75 children/teens every Sunday. Unbeliever parents are even supportive of their children attending.
- Grateful to God for the training of our children's teachers who present effective Bible teaching. Now our children are being disciplined with spiritual growth.

- Pray for the 5 Sunday Bible School teachers – that they may continue teaching the Word of God, clearly presenting that Jesus is the Christ as the Savior of the world. So far this year, we have had 5 decisions of faith!
- Please pray for one of our teachers who was finally admitted to the hospital and had to have an appendectomy. Please pray for her quick recovery as she has 2 children and is a single Mom (Paloma is her name)
- Continue to pray for our school tutoring program. We are teaching English and reading comprehension and it starts this April. This program will greatly help our students.

# HOPE FOR KAJIADO

## ... Gaye List

Kenya & East Africa



Hope for Kajiado supports three initiatives in Kenya: Kajiado Children's Home (KCH), Kajiado Valley School (KVS), and Namanga Hope Center (NHC). KCH, a home for vulnerable children, provides daily loving Christian care including grief counseling, spiritual nourishment, education and medical care. In addition, Kajiado Valley Primary and Junior High School, on the KCH campus, offers education to over 200 children from local villages, providing opportunities of spiritual nourishment. Namanga Hope Center provides school fees, food, and spiritual nourishment for over 85 orphans and has a feeding program for area families in need. Founded by an alumni of KCH, NHC aims to provide for orphans, inspired by the love and education he received at KCH. One to three mission trips are planned annually based on participant attendance.

## PRAISE

- Huge praise report for the donors that helped us to raise the needed \$17K for the collapsed water well at Kajiado's Children Home. God provided unexpected rain to replenish the underground tanks just in time to maintain sanitary functions while the well repair is underway.
- The leadership at Namanga Hope Center is providing a multi-faceted seminar for 9 students at the Namanga Hope Center is providing a multi-faceted seminar for the students on school break in April. The students suffer from quiet battles, emotional wounds, fears, rejection and loneliness. We will listen to them, speak hope into their hearts and walk with them through their battles.

## PRAYER

- Continue to pray for the water well undergoing the installation of the casings. The well is over 800 feet deep and a lot could happen to interfere with its repair.
- Please pray for the children and staff at KCH as they work on many campus projects to provide a safe and nurturing environment. Projects: the sports playfield, the old basketball court; the delayed work on the dormitory and old dining hall.
- Pray for our volunteer board who are prepared to take the largest number of interested travelers to visit KCH. Pray for travel, health, insight into what God would have us accomplish in His name, and quality time with the children we serve as we share God's love with them.

# INTERVARSITY LINK

## ... Matt and Bekah



### Southeast Europe

The Meyers have both been on staff with InterVarsity serving college students for 17 years and have been in Sarajevo for the last 5. Through LINK, the Meyers work with EUS (Evangelical Union of Students), Bosnia and Herzegovina's national evangelical college ministry. EUS in Bosnia is primarily an evangelistic, pioneering ministry. In a country of 3.5 million people, there are fewer than 500 evangelical Christians and only a handful of Christian college students. There is very little access to the Gospel.

## PRAISE

- A successful start to Alpha. We had 9 guests at our first meeting and it looks like we will have even more in the future.
- A new full time worker! Our co-worker Brogan, who had been an intern, has been offered and has accepted a full-time, long-term position here in Bosnia. We're so grateful God continues to raise up workers.
- A new student from Turkey, who we just met, has asked for and begun to read the Bible on her own and is attending Alpha.

- Pray for our language classes, that God uses them as environments to build deep relationships with students.

West Europe



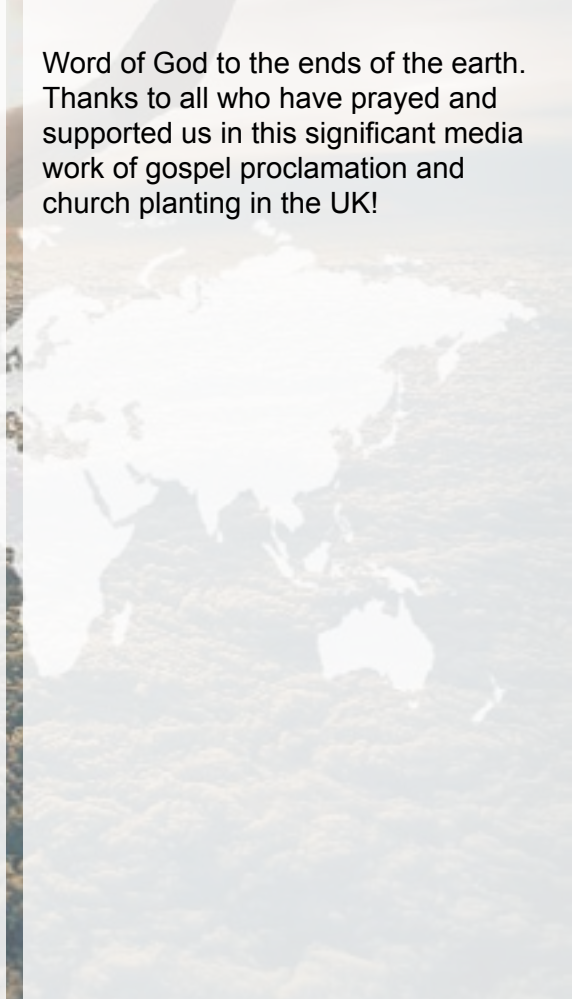
