

John 14:1-24

1. Comfort for Troubled Hearts (14:1–4)

Jesus begins by calming His disciples' fear: *"Let not your hearts be troubled."* He tells them to trust God and trust Him. He promises that in His **Father's house are many rooms**, and He is going to **prepare a place** for them and will **come again** to bring them to Himself.

2. Jesus Is the Way, the Truth, and the Life (14:5–11)

Thomas asks how they can know the way. Jesus responds with one of the most defining statements in the Gospel: **"I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me."** Philip then asks to see the Father, and Jesus explains that **to see Him is to see the Father**—their unity is complete.

3. Greater Works and Prayer in Jesus' Name (14:12–14)

Jesus promises that those who believe in Him will do **greater works** because He is going to the Father. He also assures them that prayers offered **in His name** will be answered to glorify the Father.

4. Love, Obedience, and the Coming of the Holy Spirit (14:15–24)

Love for Jesus is expressed through **obedience**. Jesus promises **another Advocate**—the **Holy Spirit**, the Spirit of truth—who will **abide with them forever**, teach them, and remind them of His words. He assures them: **"I will not leave you orphaned."** Those who love Him will experience the indwelling presence of **Father and Son**.
